Breaking news on the academic front is the final adoption of the SAT for the statewide college entrance exam, moving away from the ACT. We have begun and will continue to have discussions on how to approach the SAT.

The KSA results in all areas except science are in the district, and have been since the week of 8/4/25. The science scores were not included, and have delayed release until very late October and possibly early November.

It seems, and seemingly corroborated by consensus, that we have good instructional processes going on in both buildings. I think we have had a very good start to the year, from an academic/instructional standpoint. Conversations in the elementary are that the Bridges math program, overall, is going well. CKLA, our adopted reading program that we started last year, is going well – we have straightened the learning curve and ironed out wrinkles from last year. Hopefully the good start can be parlayed into a strong finish.

We have just passed the mid-term date for the first quarter, and parents should have received mid-term reports.

CSIP/CDIP processes have begun. The first benchmark date is October 1, for assurances and overviews.
