- d. Good News Report: The Scholastic Book Fair raised over \$7300. We welcomed many visitors to join us for lunch that week. The week of September 22 was Etown Football Homecoming Spirit Week. Kindergarten enrollment is 183 students, and preschool enrollment is 77 students. Preschool numbers continue to increase.

School Achievement Report/Data

- a. Student Achievement: Reviewed the Brigance screening data with 48% of the students ready for kindergarten and 7.7% of the students ready with enrichments. Reviewed reading and math IReady data. In reading, 9% of the students are mid or above grade level and 27% of the students are early grade level. In math, 9% of the students are mid or above grade level and 14% are early on grade level. Teachers will use reading and math WIN time as well as station teaching time to help students make progress in both areas.
