- **Kentucky School Counselor Association:** Ms. Weber and Dr. Cravens were able to attend the annual Kentucky School Counselor Association Conference September 11th and 12th. - **Terrace Metrics:** We have administered the Terrace Metrics Resiliency Screener to the majority of our 3rd-8th grade students. This is essential for us to be able to reach students who might be struggling with mental health issues or other issues that they may not know how to reach out for help with. These past few days we have met with several students and their families who have presented various concerns through the screener. We still have a few students who have been absent the last few days that we will need to screen when we return from the break.
