District Walkthroughs & Feedback

- Transitioned from **ELEOTs** to **more meaningful, actionable walkthroughs**.
- **Central office staff** from all departments conduct **scheduled and impromptu walkthroughs** in schools.
- Supports a **culture of belonging, collaboration, and shared vision**.

Innovative AI Coaching for New Teachers

PRI Grant Updates

- The grant is paying to send 4 teachers to the Innovative Schools Summit in San Antonio, TX. This conference focuses on innovative teaching strategies, at-risk students and school discipline.

As the next step in this process, students have been assigned classroom jobs, fostering leadership, ownership, and a strong sense of community.

Meniffee Central held our Fall Open House on October 7th, featuring student-led conferences and a wonderful turnout with 292 parents and guardians in attendance. During the event, we also provided parents with support for Infinite Campus and hosted a successful Book Fair, making it a meaningful evening of learning and connection for our school community.





Menifee Central Instructional Programs

- **Menifee Central has conducted 65 walkthroughs with detailed feedback and coaching notes provided to teachers.**
- **We are utilizing feedback formats and walkthrough tools developed by the KyELLN Network to ensure consistency and alignment with best practices. This is our 2nd year participating in this network.**
- **Menifee Central is participating in the PIMSER Math Professional Learning series for administrators.**
- **Our continued focus remains on high-quality instruction and student engagement across all classrooms.**



Menifee Central Community Partnerships

On September 17th Menifee County FFA members brought agriculture to life for our 5th, 6th, and 7th grade students at Menifee Central. Students participated in lessons covering livestock, horses, dairy, agricultural careers, food science and nutrition, floriculture, crops and agricultural by-products, agricultural mechanics, and forestry.

The day concluded with an assembly summarizing the lessons and rotations, featuring a keynote speech by Kentucky FFA State President Aiden Manley, who highlighted the importance of agriculture in our state and nation. During the assembly, we also recognized the winners of the "All in for Agricultural Education Week" Coloring and Poster Contest for students in Kindergarten through 7th grade.
