The current baseline for physical aggression is 7.5 instances per week, which averages out to 1.5 incidents per day during a typical 5 day school week. This data is collected in relation to physical aggression that recuires more than 1 and translated read. week. This data is collected in relation to physical aggression that requires more than 1 adult prompt/redirect. The current baseline for physical aggression when prompted for completion of academic tasks is 18.75. Over a typical 5 day school week on his current length of school day, this means that Kellin averages between 3 to 4 physically aggressive behaviors towards self or others.
