INSTRUCTION

Academic Information

We have started our PLC meetings at BMHS. We meet with every department throughout the day on Tuesday of each week. Our focus for the month of October is intentional planning with our guaranteed and viable curriculum documents. We are working to make sure our teachers clearly understand how to internalize their units, write clear learning targets and success criteria that are aligned to grade level standards, then build daily formative assessments that can inform the next steps in instruction.

We also just completed our first Academic Team intervention data review meeting. During this meeting we were able to review IXL data from our intervention groups to determine the students who are having success, the students who need to continue with the intervention, and the students who are in need of more intensive support. Our next Academic Team meeting will be on November 11th.

We have completed 25 classroom academic walkthroughs so far this year. We are really focusing on the planning piece right now and making sure we are seeing what teacher have planned out in action in the classroom

We continue to use our new MTSS Referral form with our staff, parents, and students. This form will allow us to collect data to meet the needs of our students where they are and inform our Tier 2 and Tier 2 intervention groups. This data is reviewed weekly by Erin King, Heath Conley, Deanna Hurd, and Sarah Sharp.
