Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Consider/ Approve accepting FY 2026 KETS 1st Offer of Assistance in the amount of \$53,235.00

Applicable State or Regulations: KRS 157.655-660 KAR 2:01

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: The District General Fund has budgeted to cover these offers of assistance. Upon approval, the District will match our first KETS offer of assistance in the amount of \$53,235.00 and transfer to our District Technology KETS account. This offer is based on ADA figures from 2024-2025 SEEK.

History/Background: KDE provides a yearly funding stream based on Adjusted Average Daily Attendance (AADA) as reported on the Superintendent's Annual Attendance Report (SAAR). Districts must match or escrow funds for up to three years. KRS 157.665 and KRS 157.655 establishes that in order to be eligible, districts are required to develop a plan for the expenditures of KETS funds, report on the use of these funds, and participate in the Technology Readiness Survey on an annual basis.

Pursuant to KRS 157.655-157.660 and 750 KAR 2:010, the School Facilities Construction Commission (SFCC) is hereby making an official FY2026 KETS offer of assistance to your Board of Education. Acceptance of this offer of assistance commits the Board of Education to follow the statutes and regulations of the SFCC and the Kentucky Department of Education governing the Education Technology Funding Program.

Based on the statewide ADA figures being used for 2024-2025 SEEK this year, your first offer of assistance in FY2026 is in the amount of \$53235. Accepted state technology fund offers of assistance **must be matched equally** by your Board of Education or can be escrowed for up to three (3) years.

Please note that the education technology funds restricted account has a new designation in the MUNIS chart of accounts: **Fund 2, Project 162M** EdTech account. In order for your district to receive funds, local funds should be transferred to that account.

- Excerpt of Board of Education meeting minutes (accepting, escrowing, or rejecting offer within 60 days from the date of offer)
- 3. Return the attached Fund Utilization Form Required with Journal Entry.
