The leaders at TRL continue to be so impressed with our dedicated teachers that are committed to our literacy work at Lincoln using the Science of Reading. The individual virtual learning sessions with teachers and Coach Stefany began in late September. This year we continue to focus on monthly ER Wednesday Data Days. Stefany Bragg will be coming for a full-day on Monday, November 3rd for an important professional learning session on EXPLICIT INSTRUCTION. Four LES staff members from our school attended the Annual TRL Conference earlier this month in Chicago, IL. They spent three days exposed to learning from the leading literacy experts from around our country. We continue to be so appreciative for our work with TRL and the support the district gives us in this work.
- Our student clubs are beginning! We are excited to be offering so many different club opportunities for students including: Running Club/Cross Country, Chess Club, Art Club, Academic Team, Modern Band, Student Council, Club Unify, Board Game Club, The FIVE (all boys groups), Drama Club and Girls on the Run.
