AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES AS A MASS CARE SHELTER

This agreement is made and entered into between the governing board of Christian County Schools and the Mid-West Kentucky Chapter of the American Red Cross.

Pursuant to the terms of federal statutes, the Red Cross provides emergency services in behalf of individuals and families who are victims of disaster. Christian County Schools is authorized to permit the Red Cross to use Local Schools's building, grounds, and equipment for a mass care shelter required in the conduct of Red Cross Disaster Services activities, and wishes to cooperate with the Red Cross for such purposes.

The parties hereto mutually desire to reach an understanding that will result in making Christian Co. School's facilities available to the Red Cross for the afore-Said use. Now, therefore, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

1. Christian Co. School agrees that, after meeting its responsibilities to pupils/parishioners/members/clients, it will permit, to the extent of its liability and upon request by the Red Cross, the use of its physical facilities by the Red Cross as a mass shelter for the victims of disasters.
2. The American Red Cross agrees that it shall exercise reasonable care in the conduct of its activities in such facilities and further agrees to replace or reimburse Christian Co. Schools for any foods or supplies that may be used by the Red Cross in the conduct of its relief activities.
3. Notwithstanding any other agreements, the Mid-West Kentucky Chapter of the American Red Cross agrees to defend, hold harmless, indemnify Christian Co. Schools against any legal liability in respect to bodily injury, death, and property damage, arising from the negligence of the Mid-West Kentucky Chapter during its use of the property.
