Professional Learning

- District walkthroughs are concluding at Lincoln and have begun at the High School.
- Our collaborative with Bellevue and Ludlow are in the process of setting up a meeting time with Fort Thomas schools to pick their brain on some of their teacher choice approaches to professional learning.
- Our next professional development days are November 3rd and 4th (with the opposite day being Family Engagement days at each school). Both schools will focus on the topic of Explicit Instruction on these days. The Reading League is once again leading this work.

Administrative

- Certified staff members had their professional growth plans due on 10-15-25.
- All employees were required to complete Public School Works training by 10-15-25. These are self-paced trainings on topics such as suicide awareness, blood born pathogens, seizure procedures, etc...
- Went through TEDS update training on 10-16-25.
- Our Perkins Consortium met on 10-21-25. Perkins funds are federal funds that can be utilized for specific purposes tied to career and technical education (CTE). We are in a consortium with Beechwood, Frankfort, Williamstown, and Walton-Verona.
- Declarations of Participation will be mailed to non-public schools on 10-31-25 regarding their intent to participate in the federal title funding program.
