1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the Agenda

b. Good News Report

- i. Mr. Meyers shared the success of our out-of-building students. All of our Enzweiler students are doing excellent. We do have two students struggling at Gateway, but the majority of students are doing well, and we have supports in place for the struggling students.
- ii. Mr. Meyers also shared an attendance report for the year. We have already had an increase in attendance this school year compared to the previous year- specifically, it is up 2%.
- iii. In our senior class, 28/44 students are Post-Secondary Ready.
- iv. Ms. Kohrs shared the program that Ms. Fields has started with select juniors and seniors in order to get them Post-Secondary Ready. It is the Six Sigma Global Institute-Lean Six Sigma Yellow Belt.
- v. Mr. Meyers also shared the success of our second I'Mportant meeting where Alex Meacham and his team come in once a month to mentor a group of 25 of our students.

2. Student Achievement Report/Data

- a. STAR Data-Mr. Meyers shared grade level data for the Fall test. While we are disappointed with the scores, we see the room for growth.

4. Committee Reports

- a. ELA-Mr. Fitzgerald shared a few notes about the ELA STAR Data
  - i. 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grades are all close to our goal of 50% at or above grade level.
  - ii. 11 of 61 8<sup>th</sup> graders are greater than 12.9 grade level
  - iii. 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders have 65% and 66% below the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile which is a large area of growth.
  - iv. There is a great divide between low and high-achieving students in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - v. Many of our students across the board are borderline grade-level.
  - vi. Mr. Fitzgerald also explained the 6-Step Lesson Program that DHS has implemented for our students that need extra reading intervention.
