### Stratford-upon-Avon

Take a trip through the English countryside and step back into the Elizabethan age in Stratford-upon-Avon. Here, you'll tour the half-timbered house where William Shakespeare was born. The playwright had an unmistakable influence on his hometown: today, Stratford is home to the Royal Shakespeare Theatre and a premier destination for theater lovers worldwide. Continue to Anne Hathaway's Cottage, a picturesque farmhouse where the Bard's wife spent her childhood. The Cottage is renowned for its beautiful grounds, which includes a classic English garden boasting a wide variety of flowers in a rainbow of colors.

### London

London has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. A local guide introduces you to Europe's largest city on your sightseeing tour. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. Finally, snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.

### The Lake District and Yorkshire

The Lake District is Britain's largest national park and home to many literary greats. Here you'll visit William Wordsworth's former residence at Rydal Mount. Step inside Wordsworth's ivy-covered house and see the hundreds of daffodils the poet planted as a memorial site for his daughter. Travel the quaint cobblestone streets of Haworth, where the Brontë sisters—Charlotte, Emily and Anne—penned their classics, including *Jane Eyre* and *Wuthering Heights*. At Brontë Parsonage Museum, see the home of one of English literature's most talented families. Many of the girls' pictures, manuscripts and personal treasures remain on display in the family kitchen. Then, journey through the pastoral landscapes of Yorkshire.
