  - d. Agreement that the use of any tobacco product, alternative nicotine product, or vapor product shall not occur on or in all property. The use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in school buildings or on school grounds; <u>EKJ</u> Initials
  - e. Observance that no immoral or illegal activity shall be allowed on the premises;

  - f. The presence of a school custodian at all times. The hourly wage of the custodian(s) must be included in the contract along with the social security and retirement payments required by law. If the custodian is employed beyond the normal 40-hour week that he works for the Board, overtime wages must be paid.

  - g. The presence of a food-service employee when kitchen facilities are used. The hourly wage of the employee must be included in the contract along with social security and retirement payments required by law. \_EKJ\_\_\_\_\_ Initials
  - h. Agreement that no kitchen equipment may be used outside the building;

  - i. Agreement that no alterations to the buildings or grounds be made without prior approval; <u>EKJ</u> Initials
  - j. Agreement that the renting party shall not sublease or reassign any portion of the building or item of equipment covered by the rental contract; <u>EKJ</u> Initials
  - k. Agreement that school equipment shall not be a part of the rental contract unless specifically enumerated; <u>EKJ</u> Initials
