Kindergarten Entry Screener (K Screen)

- Required screener by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE)
- The Kindergarten Entry Screener (K Screen) is a component of the state's assessment and accountability system.
- Evaluates the key predictors of school success

 The Common Kindergarten Entry Screener is a data screening tool used to help districts quickly and effectively identify children's strengths and needs, plan individualized instruction and identify children who might need tiered instruction.

Common Kindergarten Entry Screener

- Kentucky's Common Kindergarten Entry Screener, the BRIGANCE Early Childhood Kindergarten Screen III, provides a quick and accurate assessment of a child's development in five areas: Academic/Cognitive, Language, Development, Physical Development, Self-Help and Social-Emotional Development.
- The Common Kindergarten Entry Screener (704 KAR 5:070) is aligned with Kentucky's School Readiness Definition and the Kentucky Early Childhood Standards.

How is the data being used?

- A tool to gauge a child's developmental skills
- Targeted identification of students for additional supports using tiered instruction upon entering Kindergarten
- Informs early intervention strategies for the community Birth to 5 plan from the district's strategic plan
- Identifying potential delays or giftedness
- Professional learning and alignment in strategies utilized in early childhood programs (Head Start, Preschool)
- Preschool MTSS Advisory has been created to intervene early
- Communicating with parents
