<b>BACKGROUND INFORMATION:</b> Stipends and Extended Days are included on the current salary schedule, needing an amendment to reflect the current positions requiring stipends and extended days.
<b>SUMMARY OF MAJOR ELEMENTS:</b> Special Education Department requires a lead teacher within each school to ensure compliance under KDE and IDEA regulations. Currently 9 stipend extended days are listed and we need to increase to 12, to ensure three other leads are included. This information can be found on page 7 of the certified salary schedule.  Page 11, under MS-C Elementary Special Education leads one per school needs the addition of a VI teacher included for the district. This position will also need to receive a stipend.
