This is a request for approval from the Board of Education for Raptor Rehabilitation of Kentucky, Inc.(RROKI) to bring their *Birds of Prey Program* to 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students throughout the 2025-26 school year. Experienced educators require large areas like the gym to present the program in the company of their captive, rehabilitated birds of prey.

Students will learn natural history, species statistics, and individual stories of how each of the birds came into our rehabilitative care. RROKI is currently scheduled to present this program to all three grade bands at Roby and Nichols Elementary Schools. Other FRCs are planning to schedule this school year, as well. RROKI's contract and their current insurance policy are included in this request and have been reviewed and approved by BCPS' legal counsel- Dinsmore and Shohl.

Our experienced educators will come to your location and present a program with some of our avian ambassadors.
