- 1. Opening Business
  - a. Approval of the Agenda
    - i. Motion to approve the agenda made by Mrs. Kohrs, second by Mr. Ratterman. No objections.
  - b. Approval of the September Minutes

  - b. Good News Report
    - i. Mr. Meyers spoke on our strong attendance for the quarter. We are up 1.5% from our attendance at this point last year. The committee commented on the favorable calendar. The frequent breaks are helpful for teachers and students alike.
    - ii. Mr. Ratterman explained the Positive Behavior Competition that we are participating in along with our 2<sup>nd</sup> Energy Bus Rule-'Fuel your Ride with Positive Energy.'

- 2. Student Achievement Report/Data
  - a. Honor Roll/Super Honor Roll
    - i. Mr. Meyers shared the students who were on Super Honor Roll and Honor Roll for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. He did comment on the concerning number of students on honor roll compared to last year. Though this may be because of the rigor of classes and higher expectations, we would like to see more students performing at a higher level.
    - ii. Mr. Meyers also shared that the 22 sophomore students who took the SAT on a Saturday two weeks ago had an average composite score of 910-which is equivalent to around a 16 on the ACT. It isn't where we want to end, but it is a solid start being that students are only sophomores.

# 4. Committee Reports

- a. Math-Mr. Bird shared Fall STAR data from the math department:
  - i. Areas of Note:
    - 1. Class of 2029 has increased the number of students above the national average by 14%.
    - 2. Class of 2028 has increased the number of students above the national average by 6%.
    - 3. Class of 2029 increased the number of students at/above grade level by 5 students.
  - ii. Areas of Concern:
    - 1. Class of 2030 number of students above the national average has decreased by 12%.
    - 2. Concerning that the classes of 2026/27 have incomplete data. Because of all the juniors and seniors outside the building, a group of them did not complete the STAR testing.
- b. Mr. Bird shared KSA data from the math department:
  - i. Areas of Note:
    - 1. Classes 2026/27/28/29 all had increases in their Proficient/Distinguished percentages.
  - ii. Areas of Concern:
    - 1. All classes have less than 50% of students scoring Proficient/Distinguished.
