Overall I need to graduate early because being at school is costing me major setbacks in helping pay for my transportation to work and school. Also including my family moving eventually may cause me to fall behind in school. Cutting my work hours affects me a lot, and moving before finishing school would as well. Thank you for your time, I hope you understand why I need to graduate early.
