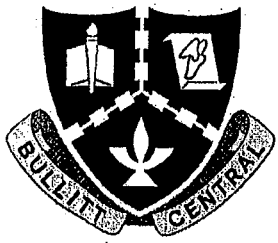



Dear Ms. Root/Bullitt Central Highschool, I am writing this letter to you today to discuss graduating early from high school. I have created a list of reasons as to why I need to graduate earlier to help support my financial needs. These include not being able to work enough hours to get the amount of money to help support my financial needs, and including my family's move soon that would change my current education opportunities.

The first reason I need to graduate early is because I cannot work enough hours during the week due to being at school in the morning. School is taking 2-3 hours out of a normal shift for me and missing those hours adds up to around 10-15 hours a week which is costing me roughly \$250 to \$300 a week. When I start working full time I will get a pay increase. Not missing these few hours could help me a lot because I have vehicular needs to pay for. This includes my insurance, and recently major vehicle repairs. Without the money to pay for these things I have no transportation to school and or work.

The second reason is my parents are fixing to move before I graduate. I do not want to go to a different school district for the last bit of my senior year, I have gotten used to Bullitt County Schools and feel I would fall behind when moving school districts. Based on all the stuff that happened when I did online school at ROC for example, they had put me into a JCTC college class.
