

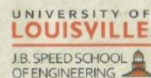

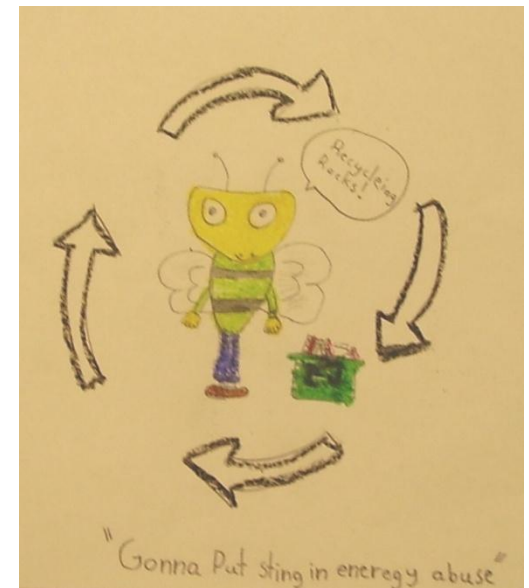
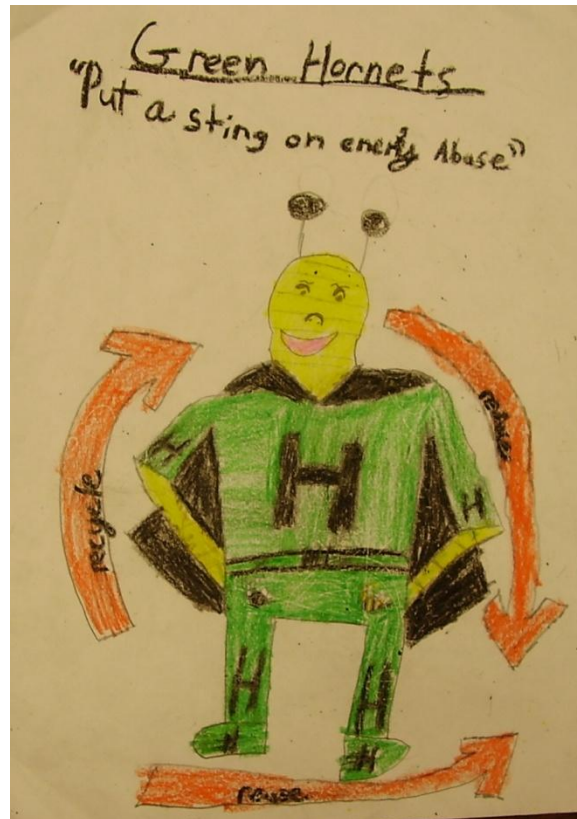

Posters by the Green Hornets at Holiday Elementary School



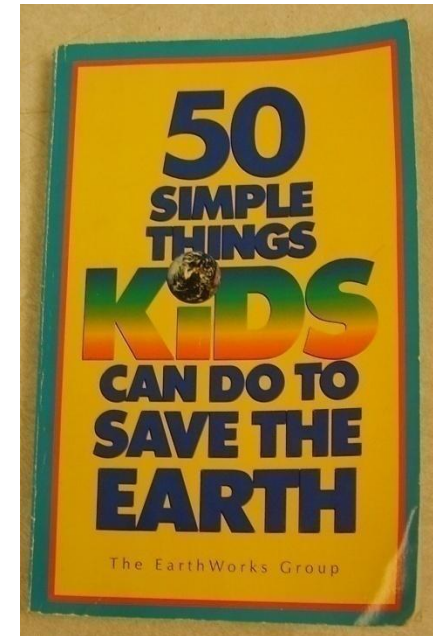


A green sticker means the lights in an empty room were turned off.

Ms. Crisp's room gets a thumbs up!

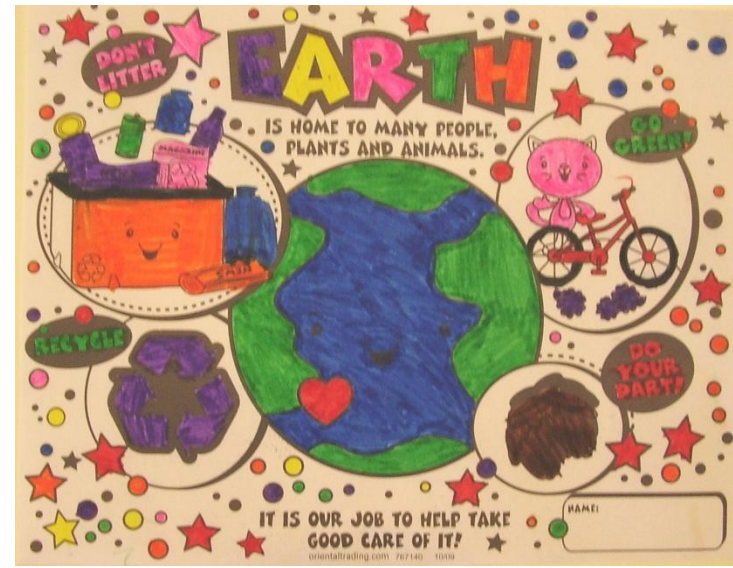
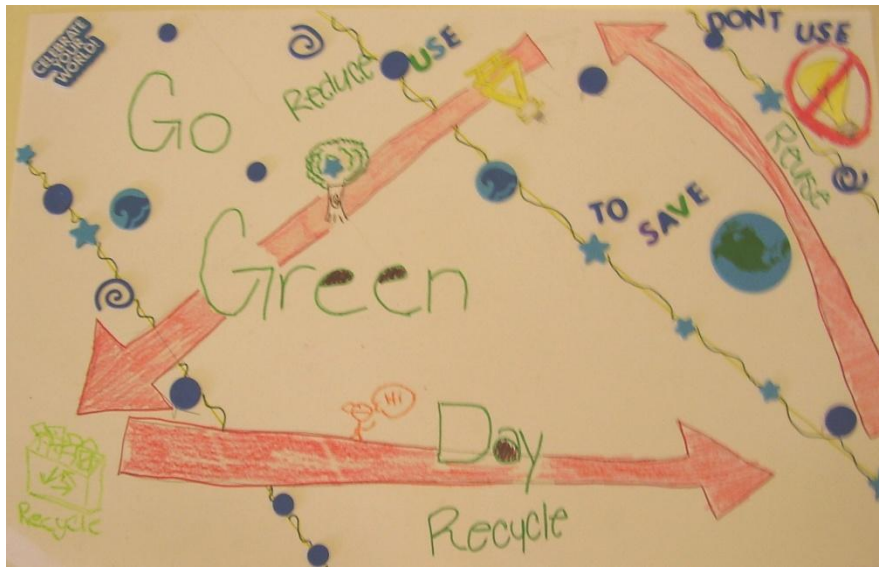

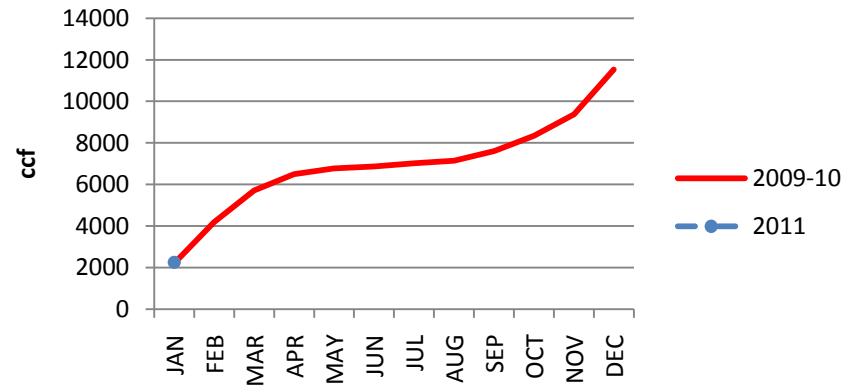
## Electricity-YTD
