Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve the contract with Facing History and Ourselves for two of MSAP Grant schools, Crawford Middle School and Breckinridge Elementary School.

Background/Rationale: Within the MSAP Grant, funds were planned to collaborate with research-based, educational consultants to assist our schools in the implementation of their magnet themes. Both Crawford Middle and Breckinridge Elementary's magnet themes are focused on student leadership and civic education. Facing History & Ourselves Inc. provides an integrated model of professional learning, curriculum alignment, and ongoing support for lesson implementation within a civic education framework. They will provide training and coaching for both MSAP schools to help guide the development and implementation of an effective civics program as part of the grant activities, goals and objectives.
