Overall Celebrations and Highlights

- Proficiency rates increased for the "all student" group in Reading, Math, Social Studies & Writing
- Middle schools improve their proficiency rates in all content areas.
- High schools improve their proficiency rates in all content areas, except Reading.
- JCPS had 3 more schools that received blue or green ratings and 12 fewer schools that received a red rating.
- Post-secondary readiness at 84.0%.
- Graduation Rate at 89.2%.
- The achievement gap between African American and White students in postsecondary readiness and graduation rates continues to close.














KSA Proficiency Rates: 3rd Grade Reading JCPS Compared to State Average



KSA Proficiency Rates: Math JCPS Compared to State Average









KSA Proficiency Rates: 8th Grade Math JCPS Compared to State Average



KSA Proficiency Rates: Science JCPS Compared to State Average






Science Proficiency Rates By Student Group







Writing Proficiency Rates By Student Group







% Students Showing Growth





English Learner Progress - Middle



English Learner Progress - High % Students Showing Growth








2025 KSA Quality of School Climate & Safety Ratings - Middle


2025 KSA Quality of School Climate & Safety Ratings - High


Postsecondary Readiness Rates



All student groups improved, with ML and ECE students showing the largest gains. The gap between African American and White students decreased by 4.7 percentage points since 2023.
