KRS 13A.3102 and KRS 13A.3104

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to KRS 13A.3102 and KRS 13A.3104, the above administrative regulation will expire in May 2026 unless the Kentucky Board of Education takes action to certify this administrative regulation. The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) has reviewed the above administrative regulation in its entirety for compliance with the current law governing the subject matter of the administrative regulation and recommends that the administrative regulation remain in effect without amendment.
