<u>Consent Agenda Item (Action Item)</u>: Approval for Four Schools to Apply for FY26 Read to Achieve (RTA) Grant (May Valley Elementary, South Floyd Elementary, Betsy Layne Elementary, Prestonsburg Elementary)

Applicable State or Regulations: This action aligns with the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) Read to Achieve (RTA) Grant Program, authorized under KRS 158.305 and supporting statutes related to early literacy instruction and intervention. The RTA Grant is designed to support evidence-based reading instruction and interventions for students in kindergarten through third grade, with a focus on closing literacy gaps through a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) framework.

<u>Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:</u> The total grant award amount varies by school based on KDE allocations. Each participating school is required to provide a local match of \$70,000, which may include a combination of district funds, personnel allocations, and approved in-kind contributions.

<u>History/Background:</u> The Read to Achieve (RTA) Grant is a competitive KDE grant that supports improved reading outcomes for students in kindergarten through third grade through evidence-based instruction and interventions. Floyd County Schools has consistently prioritized early literacy and data-driven instruction as district improvement goals. Based on recent assessment data and school improvement planning, May Valley Elementary, South Floyd Elementary, Betsy Layne Elementary, and Prestonsburg Elementary were identified as strong candidates for participation in the FY26 RTA grant cycle.

**Recommended Action:** It is recommended that the Floyd County Board of Education approve authorization for the following schools to submit applications for the FY26 Read to Achieve (RTA) Grant:
