2026-2027 School Calendar for BCPS

Dear Dr. Bacon,

The BCPS Calendar Committee convened on November 17, 2025, to develop a preliminary survey to solicit community feedback regarding the current calendar format. The results of this initial survey are attached for your review.

Following an analysis of the results, the Committee developed 4 distinct calendar options. These options were presented to the Calendar Committee on December 2nd. The Calendar Committee then removed the 4th option and would like to present 3 options for approval to be included in a subsequent community-wide survey. This voting survey will be distributed on December 3rd and will close on Friday, December 5th. Upon the conclusion of the voting period, we will review the findings and submit the community's preferred calendar to the Board of Education for official approval.

Pursuant to the process for school calendar adoption, the Board of Education is required to hold two (2) separate meetings: 1) a session for discussion of the Calendar Committee's results and presentation of the calendar recommendation, and 2) a subsequent session for the official adoption of the calendar. These meetings may be conducted during a regular or special session.


We intend to present the survey results to the Board during the regular meeting on Monday, December 15th. At that time, we will recommend that the Board officially adopt the 25-26 school calendar during their regular meeting scheduled for January 12th.




CURRENT CALENDAR FEEDBACK

Satisfaction with the current BCPS calendar on a scale of 1 (Very Dissatisfied) to 5 (Very Satisfied).



What respondents like most about the current calendar:

- Breaks are highly valued: Respondents overwhelmingly appreciate the number, spacing, and length of breaks, especially the full week for Fall and Spring break, and the two weeks for Christmas break.
- Bullitt Days are beneficial: Many like the inclusion of "Bullitt Days," particularly when they are strategically placed after long breaks to extend time off or for teacher preparation/planning.
- Traditional and Predictable Schedule: A significant number of responses favor the current calendar because it is traditional, familiar, consistent year-to-year, and easy for families to plan around.



CURRENT CALENDAR FEEDBACK CONTINUED


What respondents wished was different about the calendar:

- Later School Start Date: A significant number of responses requested starting the school year later in August, with some suggesting after the Kentucky State Fair or even after Labor Day, to extend the summer break, often citing hot weather.
- Changes to Holiday Breaks: A full week off for Thanksgiving was a popular request, and there were also mentions of wanting longer Christmas, Fall, and Spring breaks. Conversely, some suggested shorter Fall breaks.
- General Satisfaction/No Change: Many responses indicated satisfaction with the current calendar or explicitly stated "Nothing" or "Leave it alone," suggesting a preference for the status quo.

Importance of a full week of Fall Break on a scale of 1 (Not Important) to 5 (Very Important).




Importance of a full week of Spring Break on a scale of 1 (Not Important) to 5 (Very Important).

Importance of concluding the school year by the Friday of the week of Memorial Day.




Additional comments or suggestions regarding the BCPS calendar, with the understanding that the School Calendar Committee cannot consider comments/concerns regarding Bullitt Days and NTI days:

- Concerns about School Closures for Early Voting: A significant number of responses object to closing schools for an entire week for early voting, calling it "ridiculous" and "unnecessary". There is a strong consensus that the County Clerk should utilize alternative locations for voting.
- Opposition to Schedule Changes (Start/End Times): The majority of comments strongly oppose switching elementary school start times to earlier and high school start times to later.
- Interest in Alternative Calendar Structures: Some comments express interest in a "variable calendar" or year-round school" with shorter summer breaks and longer breaks throughout the year, Many expressed a" need for more detailed information or a mock calendar to understand the full impact.

VARIABLE CALENDAR FEEDBACK

Based on respondents' understanding of a Traditional vs a Variable calendar, which structure is

preferred?




Perceived benefits of a variable calendar:

- Longer Summer/Later Start Date: A significant number of responses cited a later school start date in August and a consequently longer summer break as a key benefit, allowing more family time and vacation flexibility, avoiding the hottest time of the year, and aligning with the State Fair.
- Flexibility and Reduced Day Requirements: Many respondents noted the benefit of the variable calendar
 not requiring a set number of school days, but rather focusing on instructional hours, which provides more
 flexibility for making up time lost due to weather/snow days and potentially leading to fewer school days
 overall.
- **Potential for Changes in Breaks:** Some saw benefits in a shorter or eliminated Fall Break, while others mentioned the possibility of more frequent or longer breaks, or better alignment with college schedules.

Perceived drawbacks of a variable calendar:

- Reduced/Eliminated Fall Break: The most frequent drawback cited is the shortening or complete loss of the full week for Fall Break, which many families use for vacations and family time.
- Late Start and End Dates: Starting school later in August is a major concern, as it could mean the school year will end later, potentially extending into June.
- Childcare: There is fear that a variable calendar could lead to increased childcare issues and costs, especially during a longer summer break or with shorter, more frequent breaks.



Moving Forward: Our Next Steps

We are currently working on calendar options informed by the survey results. These options will be shared with the Calendar Committee for their input and feedback during our next meeting on December 2nd. Following this, another survey featuring various calendar choices will be sent out to the community for additional feedback on December 3rd. Finally, a recommendation for the 2026-2027 calendar will be presented to the Board for approval at the Regular Meeting on December 15th.
