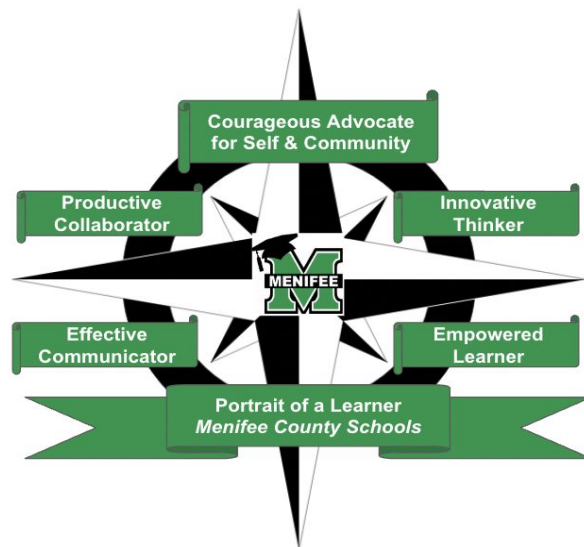




Principals' Report

Navigating with Purpose: A Pathway to the Future





Menifee Central Instruction/Progress Monitoring

- Students in grades K–7 completed the second i-Ready assessment.
- Our school demonstrated growth in **every grade level** as a whole-school improvement.
 - **Reading Tier I** performance increased from **17% to 35%**.
 - **Math Tier I** performance increased from **8% to 18%**.
- Kindergarten showed notable growth in **Reading Tier I**, increasing by **from 10% to reach 69%**.
- Third grade showed strong improvement, with students in **Reading Tier I** increasing from **22% to 39%**.
- Data was reviewed and analyzed as school and all teachers identified their weakest iReady domain made an instruction plan to support tier 1 instruction and for intervention.

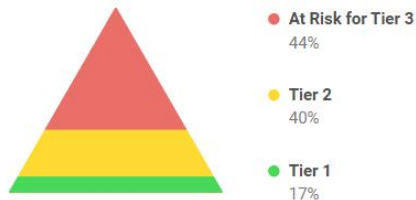


iReady Reading Data Comparison

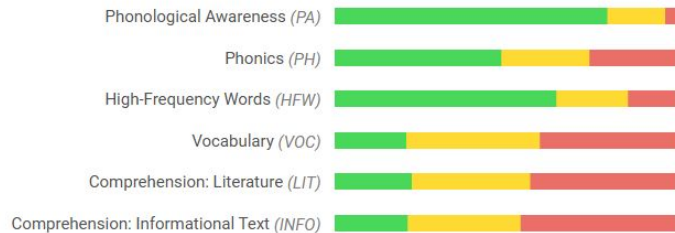

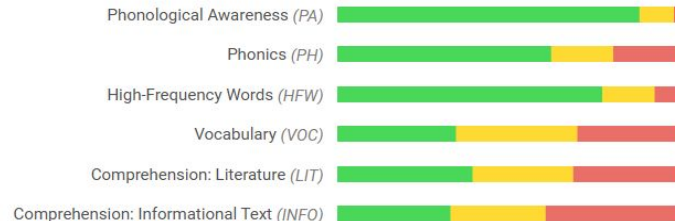

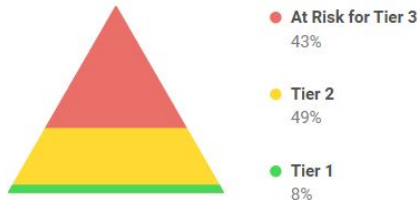


iReady Math Data Comparison

Beginning of Year Compared to Winter Assessment

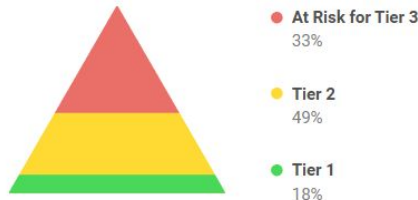

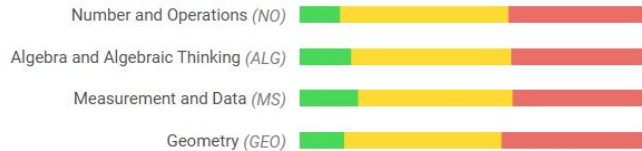

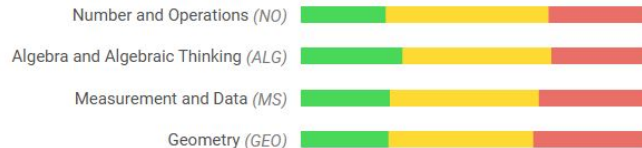


Placement By Domain

Menifee County High School Instruction/Progress Monitoring

Our 8th grade students recently completed their iReady assessments, a diagnostic tool that identifies each student's current skill level in reading and math. iReady provides detailed data showing students' strengths, areas for growth, and how they progress over time. Our most recent results highlight strong growth in reading for many students, with a large group performing at or above grade level, especially those in advanced courses. We also saw positive movement in math for several students, particularly those moving from approaching to proficient levels. This data will help us plan targeted instruction and support to ensure every student continues to grow.
