History/Background:

May Valley Elementary School is requesting approval to utilize Renaissance Learning digital instructional resources, specifically Nearpod and Flocabulary, to enhance classroom instruction and student engagement across grade levels. These platforms provide standards-aligned lessons, interactive content, formative assessments, and multimedia resources that support diverse learning styles and promote active participation.

Nearpod offers interactive, teacher-led lessons with embedded assessments, real-time feedback, and student collaboration opportunities. Flocabulary uses music and culturally relevant content to reinforce academic vocabulary, comprehension, and critical thinking skills across content areas.




Recommended Action:
