- MCHS staff completed professional learning on January 5.
 - Teachers completed curriculum-based planning for the next unit of instruction. Planning focused on curriculum pacing, progress monitoring, and instructional adjustments. Content area teachers utilized the unit internalization protocol.
 - Teachers also complete professional development addressing student behaviors provided by KEDC.
- The administrative team has submitted required evidence for the diagnostic review and is preparing for the upcoming presentation to the review team in February.
- The leadership team will begin meeting with the diagnostic review team in January and has already begun meeting regularly with ER staff.
- MCHS Tier I meetings are scheduled to support and monitor instructional practices.

Menifee County High School Community Engagement

The Menifee County FFA chapter has been named a recipient of the Kentucky Department of Agriculture's Raising Hope Grant to raise awareness and education to farm and rural safety issues relevant to our community. Under the direction of Menifee County FFA Advisor, Julie Lane, and leadership of Menifee County FFA Secretary and Menifee County Fire Department member, Patrick Abney, the grant will fund the following initiatives in the spring semester:

Local First Responder's Appreciation Dinner to be served by Menifee County FFA members.

Training for First Responders for Tractor & ATV Accidents.

Mock Accident and Tractor & ATV Safety Event for MCHS Students in May.

(Student participants will be given the opportunity to receive an ATV helmet.)

This program will answer direct and pressing needs for the safety of students, and first responders in the community. The program will be implemented in phases and will kick off in the spring semester after the disbursement of funds from the Kentucky FFA Foundation. The grant total amount will be \$5,000 to implement these projects.
