Curriculum, Instruction, Assessment

- The phase three documents of CSIP / CDIP were all submitted to KDE and we are now officially in phase four:
 - PD Plan for Schools/ District, NTI Continuation of Learning, English Learning Plan for Districts (Lau Plan), Progress Monitoring
