**HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Kentucky Association of School Superintendents (KASS), in partnership with the Kentucky Center for Leadership and Franklin-Covey, has developed “Synergy,” an executive-level leadership experience for veteran Kentucky superintendents. The program consists of three statewide sessions (February, April, and June) that provide advanced leadership development, collaboration with senior business executives, and superintendent-exclusive professional learning.
