

School Staffing Guidelines – Allocation Formula

The Newport Independent Schools shall assign each school the certified and classified personnel in numbers that meet at least the minimum state requirements.

Calculations are based on the end of the 6th month of the current year to project enrollment of students for the ensuing year. Allocations will be adjusted by September 15, based on actual enrollment. Allocations do not include non-resident projections.

Allocations do not include federal programs staffed at the school such as special education and Title I. Teacher staffing ratios will be rounded to the nearest whole. Projected enrollment shall be reduced by the full-time equivalency of students in self-contained classrooms. Projected enrollment shall be reduced by the full-time equivalency of students who are non-residents for the purposes of allocations.
