Meeting called to order at 2:50 PM by Chairperson Meyers

1. Opening Business

a. Approval of the Agenda

b. Approval of the November Minutes

b. Good News Report

- i. Mr. Meyers shared that we have 69 students exempt from midterm exams, including one freshman.

ii. Mr. Meyers also shared Dayton KCSS Assessment Report.

1. Some highlights he shared were:

- a. 91.1% of students had a trusted adult in the building
- b. Majority of students, staff, and parents all reported feeling safe while at DHS.
- c. Over 95% of survey respondents indicated that our building is clean and well-maintained.
- d. Many staff members indicated that the morale of the building is consistently high and positive.
- e. A high percentage of staff (93.3%) reported good communication between them and the administration.
- f. Survey results indicate that 99.3% of students and 96.4% of parents reported being taught the school rules and consequences.
