History/Background: Schools on behalf of competitors of sanctioned events that earn advancement to state or national tournaments/competitions may request up to \$2,000.00 to assist with associated travel expenses. This includes events sponsored by KHSAA, KAAC, NASP. Etc. and does not apply to individual events. Financial support shall not be granted to invitational events. Prestonsburg High School has 16 students that placed in the Regional Competition and earned a spot to compete in the State Competition in Lexington.
