Applicable State or Regulations: Board Policy 01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board of Education.

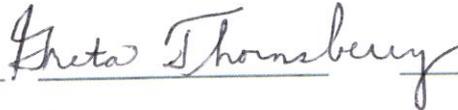

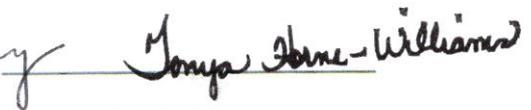

Floyd Central High School has 1 student that placed 2nd in the Regional Competition and earned a spot to compete in the state competition in Lexington.
