Recommendation/Motion: A motion to approve comprehensive school improvement plans.

Background/Rationale: Schools shall focus their improvement efforts through the collaborative development of a Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP) involving all stakeholders to review, revise and communicate a purpose for student success, establish and address priority needs, plan for the usage of District funds and develop action plans to close achievement gaps between various student groups. This plan shall describe the specific goals and activities that build capacity for high-quality planning to address targeted needs to achieve the goals established by the state-mandated accountability system. The structure of the CSIP shall include completion of the Continuous Improvement Diagnostic between August 1 and October 1 of each school year and completion of the needs assessment between October 1 and November 1 of each school year. The primary purposes of the CSIP shall be: To improve student achievement on state and federal mandated testing/accountability instruments; and To eliminate achievement gaps among various student groups. The school's plan for eliminating achievement gaps among various groups of students shall be presented and approved by the School Based Decision Making Council in December and to the Board annually for its review and comment. The Board may share its comments, in writing, with the council.
