Key Takeaways:

- Grade 3 reading shows positive growth, indicating students are building stronger literacy foundations as they move toward upper elementary.
- Grade 3 math projected proficiency is a strength, reflecting effective early numeracy instruction.
- Nearly half of Grade 8 students are projected proficient in reading, supporting readiness for high school.
- Grade 7 remains a key transition focus, with targeted instructional supports already in place.



Calendar Changes

- As of now, we are not taking spring break. If more days are missed, we will survey staff and parents to look at options.
- *All 10 NTI Days have been used.*
- *We have missed seven snow days that need to be made up to reach the 170 days required for the calendar.*
- *We have added the two professional learning days for March back as student attendance days. The other five days have been added to the end of the year.*
- *The current last day for students will be Wednesday, May 27, 2026.*
- *There will be no school on Memorial Day.*
- *Teachers will work the two professional learning days this week with closing day on Monday, June 1, 2026. This will meet the 185 days required for their contracts.*
- *We are hopeful that legislators let us use hours instead of days, since this was a state-wide weather event.*
