As State Representative for House District 58 (Shelby County), I respectfully request additional information and clarification regarding the decision made by the Kentucky High School Athletic Association Board of Control on January 15, 2026, to reassign Shelbyville's Cornerstone Christian Academy from the 30th District to the 29th District, effective for the 2026-27 school year and beyond.

I am joined in this request by my colleagues State Representative Jason Nemes and State Senator Aaron Reed, both of whom also represent Shelby County constituents. We appreciate the complexities involved in district and regional alignments and the Board's responsibility to ensure balanced and fair competition across the Commonwealth.

To better understand the rationale and process underlying this specific determination - and to assist constituents who have raised concerns - we kindly ask that you provide responses to the questions below, along with any relevant documents requested.

- 1. Does the Board of Control have a written policy or set of guidelines for moving a school from one district to another? If such written policy or guidelines exist, please send a copy to us.*
- 2. Upon what basis did the Board of Control decide to move Cornerstone into the 29th District?*
- 3. How many other KHSAA member schools are currently placed in districts outside their geographic area, requiring their sports teams to travel past multiple schools in their area to compete against schools farther away?*

Thank you for your attention to our requests for information and for your continued service to Kentucky's student athletes.
