BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Per Board Policy - Board must establish all new positions.

SUMMARY OF MAJOR ELEMENTS:

The board is requested to establish/add an additional Migrant Education Program Assistant position to serve an Advocate/Recruiter role for the district. The Migrant numbers continue to increase and are currently at 103 enrolled students and 19 in the birth-5 range. In turn, the allocation of Title I - Part C funds has increased significantly from \$124,222 in FY25 to \$258,254 in FY26. In addition, there was a reallocation of funds from the FY25 budget from the state that awarded an additional \$3007. This position will allow for additional support to migrant families.

IMPACT ON RESOURCES: No impact on the general fund as this position will be funded with Title I - Part C which is dedicated to Migrant Education Programming.
