**PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

- Second semester walkthroughs are ongoing at both schools.
- Mr. Taylor and I will be attending Covington Independent's Artificial Intelligence PD on March 16<sup>th</sup>.

**ASSESSMENT**

- Attended state required DAC training of 2/16 in preparation for May's Kentucky Summative Assessment.
  - The most major change from last year's Kentucky Summative Assessment is that the state has returned to not having a field test as part of On-Demand Writing, meaning that the students in grades 5, 8, and 11 that take that test only complete one essay instead of two.
- ACCESS testing was completed the week of 2/9. ACCESS testing measures the academic progress of English Learner students. Thank you to Mrs. Greene for her leadership on this!
- Two SAT opportunities will be held at DHS. Freshman and sophomore students may name the test on March 24<sup>th</sup>. Up to 50 students in those grades may take the assessment. All juniors will take the test on March 31<sup>st</sup>.
- The March 31<sup>st</sup> state administration is pushed back from an original date of March 10<sup>th</sup>. The High School leadership team are scheduling additional trainings through TorchPrep to attempt to move the needle as much as possible with this new (to us) assessment, and the extra time allows for the scheduling of this.
