

Title I, Part A and Title IV

Consolidated Monitoring is scheduled for March 3, 4, and 5th through the Kentucky Department of Education. Through this process, KDE reviews district policies, procedures, fiscal records, program implementation, and evidence of effectiveness to confirm that programs are implemented effectively and accurately. School Calendar

The proposed 2026–2027 school calendar includes 171 instructional days and introduces two dedicated Parent and Family Engagement Days, strategically scheduled during key times identified by staff to connect with families and support student engagement and re-engagement. We are seeking approval to pilot these engagement days in place of the traditional Home Visit Day for the 2026-2027 school year. The calendar also provides built-in flexibility for teacher professional learning, offering a variety of professional development options scheduled at strategic points to respond to student data and meet teacher-identified growth needs—supporting both staff growth and student success while remaining responsive to the needs of families.
