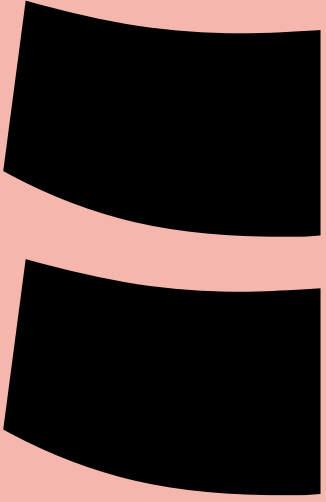

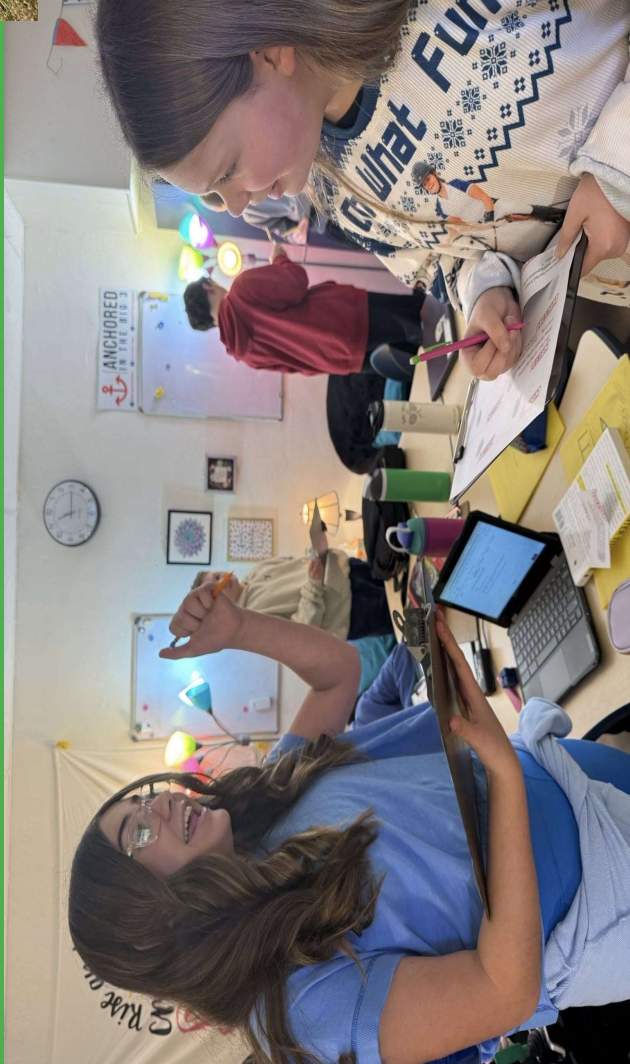

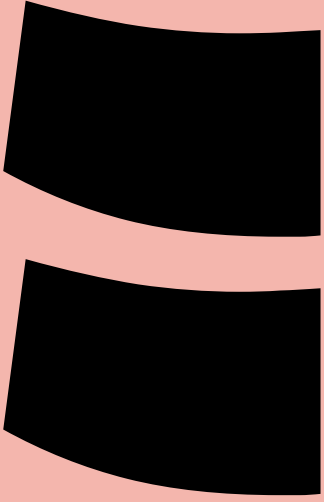

# Assessment Results

The MAP assessment is our universal screener used 3X a year. MAP stands for **Measures of Academic Progress**. We use this test to track our progress over time in reading, math, and language.

The next four celebrations are related to our most recent testing window in December.



**6. Intervention may begin for students at the 50th percentile!**

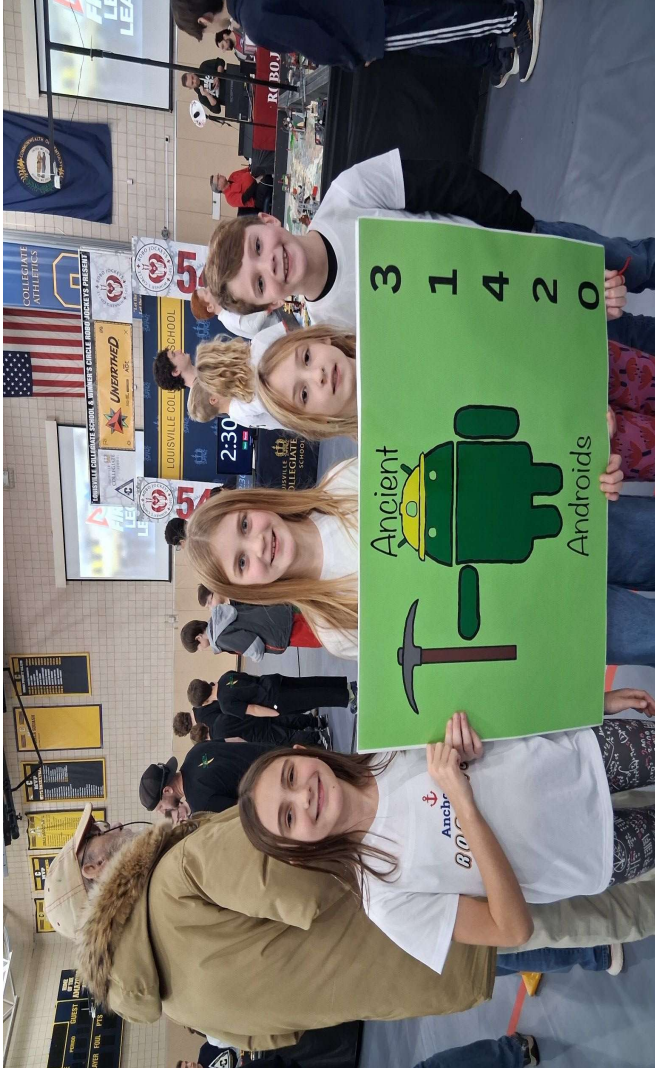
**5. All grade levels are on track to show one year's growth in one year's time!**

**4. Seven of Nine Grade Levels are scoring at or above the 95th national percentile in Reading and Math! The other two grade levels are scoring at the 84th percentile and above in reading and math!**

**3. 6/6 grade levels are scoring above the 94th percentile in the nation on the Language Assessment!**
