Potential programs include wellness education, grief and divorce support, health and nutrition services, anger management, peer mediation, and more.</p> <p>A. Groups will be limited to 20–30 students to promote meaningful discussion. Participation will be based on referrals from staff, guidance counselors, and FRYSC.</p> <p>A. YSC and volunteers will support the groups by providing lesson plans, coordinating meeting times and spaces, identifying students in need, creating parent permission forms, and communicating with school staff and teachers. YSC will also supply all materials and resources needed to sustain the program.</p> <p>B. YSC will lead and facilitate weekly groups at TCHA, incorporating guest speakers and additional programs to teach life skills and character development.
