



## Postsecondary Enrollment for Class of 2025 Breakdown by Race/Ethnicity




# Retention and Persistence for Class of 2024



## Retention and Persistence for Class of 2024 Breakdown by Race/Ethnicity




## Graduation Outcomes for Class of 2019

### Are students **COMPLETING** a credential?

Out of **145 total students** in this cohort year, **19% or 27** earned at least one credential and are considered a **completer**.

2020 - 15% (7% earned at least a bachelor's degree)
