

Applicable State or Regulations:

KRS 160.160 Powers and Duties of the Local Board of Education.

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

Maximum \$2,000.00 for expenses associated with 2026 JAG National Career Development Conference in Salt Lake City, UT.

History/Background:

Schools on behalf of competitors of sanctioned events that earn advancement to state or national tournaments/competitions may request up to \$2,000.00 to assist with associated travel expenses. This includes events sponsored by KHSAA, KAAC, NASP, etc. Financial support shall not be granted to invitational events. PHS JAG had 4 students that placed at the State Competition, and will be competing at Nationals in Salt Lake City.

Recommended Action:

Approve up to \$2,000.00 to help cover travel expenses.
