**SBDM Minutes**

- I. The meeting was called to order at 3:15 pm by Hope Janes

- II. The council reviewed the current agenda. Angela Rucker made the motion to approve the agenda. Chris Appelman seconded the motion. All were in consensus. The council reviewed the January 15th, 2026 regular minutes. Jennifer Weaver made the motion to accept the minutes. Chanty Headspeth seconded the motion. All were in consensus. In public comment, the council will be moving the April 16th regularly scheduled meeting to April 23rd due to many SBDM members attending the 8th grade trip on the 16th.
