The week of February 9, the staff and students showed their Panther Pride by participating in Basketball Homecoming Spirit Days. Scholastic Book Fair was hosted that week, also, where over \$5000 in books and materials were sold.

### School Achievement Report/Data

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- a. Student Achievement: The intervention team is focusing effort on those students who are in Tier 2 and 3. Support is given to those students who are scoring below the 20th percentile on iReady and not making progress with ESGI data, if space is available in those groups.
