CONCERN:

Consider Approval of the Summer Feeding Program for La Grange Elementary for the 2026/2027 School Year.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to federal guidelines, school districts may sponsor the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), currently branded as SUN Meals, to provide nutritional support during the summer months. This program offers no-cost meals to children aged 18 and younger, as well as qualifying individuals ages 19–21 with documented mental or physical disabilities who are enrolled in educational programs under an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

The School Nutrition Department proposes the continuation of the SFSP at La Grange Elementary School for the summer of 2026. Eligibility is based on the school's free and reduced-price meal percentage, which meets the USDA requirements for a "low-income area" designation. The department will provide breakfast and lunch services in strict accordance with USDA nutritional guidelines, with the requirement that all meals be consumed on-site.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the implementation of the Summer Food Service Program at La Grange Elementary School for the 2026 summer term.
