**Memorandum of Agreement
Between
Jefferson County Board of Education
And
TECH-Nique, Inc.**

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into between the Jefferson County Board of Education (hereinafter "JCPS"), a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, with its principal place of business at 3332 Newburg Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40218, TECH-Nique, Inc. (hereinafter "TECH-Nique, Inc."), a nonprofit organization with its principal place of business at 2030 Poloview Place, Louisville, Kentucky, 40245.

WHEREAS, TECH-Nique, Inc. and JCPS are collaborating on All That TECH, an interactive technology education program designed to provide JCPS students with immersive learning experiences that foster skills in technology, critical thinking, and problem-solving, with plans to bring this experience to a maximum of twelve high schools within JCPS; and

WHEREAS, this partnership aims to engage students in innovative, culturally relevant tech education that aligns with JCPS's goals of preparing students for future workforce opportunities and creating pathways to technology careers.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement, JCPS and TECH-Nique, Inc. agree that they will collaborate on All That TECH as described below.

I. TECH-Nique, Inc. AGREES to:

- a) **Deliver the All That TECH Program:** Provide engaging, culturally relevant, and immersive technology education experiences for students at up to twelve JCPS high schools, tailored to foster skills in technology, critical thinking, and problem-solving.
- b) **Provide Qualified Instructors and Facilitators:** Ensure that skilled educators, facilitators, and guest speakers with expertise in technology and workforce development are available to deliver program content and guide student learning.
- c) **Supply Necessary Materials and Technology Resources:** Supply all necessary materials, technology tools, and resources to support the program's curriculum and activities, ensuring students have hands-on access to relevant tech experiences.
- d) **Coordinate Program Logistics with JCPS:** Work with JCPS staff to coordinate scheduling, program delivery, and school-specific logistics, ensuring a smooth implementation at each participating high school.
- e) Follow all JCPS health and safety guidelines when staff, students, or volunteers enter JCPS buildings.
- f) Not use the name or logo of JCPS, All That TECH, or individual JCPS schools in any printed materials, websites, videos, or social media without prior approval from the JCPS Chief of Communications.

- g) No contractor, employee, intern, or volunteer shall be utilized to supervise students or deemed to have the authority to supervise students unless the volunteer has been designated to supervise students by the Principal and approved by the Superintendent/designee. The volunteer has undergone all required records check.
- h) TECH-Nique, Inc. will assume that the volunteers/contractors/employees under the supervision of JCPS staff shall comply in all material respects with all applicable laws and regulations and all applicable JCPS policies and procedures of which JCPS informs TECH-Nique, Inc.
- i) If the performance of this Agreement involves the transfer by JCPS to TECH-Nique, Inc. of any data regarding any student that is subject to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, 20 U.S.C. 1232g as amended, ("FERPA"), TECH-Nique, Inc. agrees to:
 - 1) In all respects, comply with the provisions of FERPA, including any requirements of Chapter 99 of Title 34 of the Code of Federal Regulations and any other applicable state or federal law.
 - 2) Use any such data for no purpose other than to fulfill the purposes of this Agreement, and not share any such data with any person or entity other than TECH-Nique, Inc. and its employees, contractors, volunteers, and agents, without prior approval of JCPS. Disclosure shall be limited to only those employees, contractors, volunteers, or agents who are necessary for the fulfillment of this Agreement.
 - 3) Require all employees, contractors, volunteers, and agents of TECH-Nique, Inc. to comply with all applicable provisions of FERPA with respect to any such data. TECH-Nique, Inc. shall require and maintain confidentiality Agreements with each employee, contractor, volunteer, or agent with access to data pursuant to this Agreement.
 - 4) Maintain any such data in a secure environment, whether physical or electronic, and not copy, reproduce, or transmit any such data except as necessary to fulfill the purposes of this Agreement. TECH-Nique, Inc. shall notify JCPS within 24 hours in the event of any data breach or disclosure of data to any person or entity other than the parties listed in this agreement.
 - 5) Collect, store, and maintain data in a manner that does not permit the identification of an individual student by anyone other than employees, contractors, or agents of TECH-Nique, Inc. necessary for the fulfillment of this Agreement and having a legitimate interest related to the purposes of this Agreement in knowing such personal identification, and not disclose any such data in a manner that would permit the identification of an individual student in any form,

including, but not limited to, published results of studies.

- 6) Destroy or return to JCPS any such data obtained under this Agreement within thirty days (30) after the date by which TECH-Nique, Inc. no longer needs it for the purposes of this Agreement. TECH-Nique, Inc. will require all employees, contractors, volunteers, or agents of any kind to comply with this provision.
- k) JCPS retains the right to audit TECH-Nique, Inc.'s compliance with the confidentiality requirements of this provision.
- n) For any projects, involving research, program evaluation, minoring activities, or data collection of any kind, JCPS student or staff participation is voluntary. As a federally authorized Institutional Review Board (IRB), JCPS complies with the federal definition for research, which includes sharing of Personally Identifiable Information (PII) for the purpose of answering a question or evaluating activities for effectiveness beyond standard educational or operational procedures. Thus, all research, program evaluation and data collection activities must be approved by the JCPS IRB and shall not begin before approval is secured from the JCPS IRB.
- n) TECH-Nique, Inc. acknowledges that any violation of this Agreement and/or the provisions of FERPA or accompanying regulations related to the nondisclosure of protected student information constitutes just cause for JCPS to immediately terminate this Agreement pursuant to Article V of this Agreement.
- o) TECH-Nique, Inc. will maintain an all-risk property and casualty insurance policy with respect to the facilities and a policy of commercial general liability in amounts no less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 per policy and provide JCPS with a certificate of insurance upon request.
- p) TECH-Nique, Inc. understands and agrees that the All That TECH may not interfere with the instructional program of JCPS.
- q) To the extent that JCPS facilities are closed to students or restricted to visitors, those facilities will also be unavailable to TECH-Nique, Inc. During any periods of the Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) or remote learning, JCPS facilities will not be available to TECH-Nique, Inc., staff, students, volunteers, or contractors.

II. JCPS agrees to:

- a) **Provide Access to Participating Schools:** Allow TECH-Nique access to JCPS high schools for the purpose of implementing the *All That TECH* program, coordinating with school staff and administration as needed.
- b) **Facilitate Student Engagement and Participation:** Assist in promoting student involvement in the program by communicating with school staff about the *All That TECH* initiative and its benefits.

c) **Assign Staff for Program Support and Oversight:** Designate appropriate JCPS staff to support and oversee the program's implementation at each participating school) ensuring that TECH-Nique has the necessary guidance and oversight to comply with JCPS policies.

d) **Communicate Relevant Policies and Procedures:** Inform TECH-Nique of all applicable JCPS policies, procedures, and requirements that are necessary for the program's operation, including any updates throughout the duration of the partnership.

e) Provide payment in the amount of \$6,600.00 per *All That TECH* Program/Conference implemented at a JCPS school to TECH-Nique, Inc., to be paid within 45 days of invoice receipt.

III. General Conditions

- a) ALL parties will designate individual(s) to serve as liaison in order to facilitate matters in a reasonable and timely manner.
- b) Failure to comply with the foregoing provisions will constitute just cause for JCPS to immediately terminate this Agreement pursuant to Article V of this Agreement.

IV. Period of Performance and Termination

This Agreement shall be in effect for the period beginning March 31, 2026 and May 28, 2027. Any party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving the others 30 days' written notice. The Jefferson County Board of Education may terminate this Agreement immediately in the event that student confidentiality or safety is deemed to be in jeopardy or for any other reason the Superintendent determines is in the best interest of the school. This Agreement may be terminated immediately by JCPS upon ten (10) business days' written notice to TECH-Nique, Inc. for its failure to cure a material breach of this Agreement.

V. Modification

No waiver, alteration or modification of the provisions of this Agreement shall be binding unless in writing and mutually agreed upon by JCPS and TECH-Nique, Inc.

VI. Equal Opportunity

During the performance of this Agreement TECH-Nique, Inc. and Bluegrass Community Foundation shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of

1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Kentucky Equal Employment Act of 1978, KRS 45.550-45.640, and the American Disabilities Act, and shall not discriminate against any JCPS employee, student or student's, parent or guardian because of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital or parental status, political affiliations or beliefs, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, veteran status, genetic information, or disability or limitations related to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.

VII. Independent Parties

In the performance of the duties and obligations imposed on each party by this Agreement, it is mutually understood and agreed that each party shall act as an independent contractor with respect to JCPS, and no party shall be construed to be an agent or representative of the other party.

VIII. Captions

Section titles or captions contained in the Agreement are inserted only as a matter of convenience and reference and in no way define, limit, extend or describe the scope of this Agreement or the intent of any provisions hereof.

IX. VIII. Entire Agreement

This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between JCPS and TECH-Nique, Inc. regarding All That TECH and supersedes any and all prior Agreements.

It must be scalable to serve up to twelve high schools and provide qualified instructors, facilitators, and guest speakers with expertise in technology and workforce development. Additionally, the program should supply all necessary hands-on technology resources and include community-focused events.

What steps did you take (i.e. research) to determine this was the only vendor available?

TECH-Nique, Inc. was selected through a collaborative process with JCPS to develop the All That TECH program from the ground up. This partnership aligns the curriculum with JCPS's goals of preparing students for future workforce opportunities and creating diverse technology career pathways. Co-developed to address district needs—including high school student facilitators and school-specific logistics—the program offers a unique service. This joint development integrates immersive learning and targeted outreach to non-traditional students, features not available from standard vendors.

- a) Plan, implement, and facilitate a four-day tech conference for middle school students during the month of June 2022.
- b) Hire high school juniors/seniors to serve as facilitators during the conference
- c) Facilitate speakers to speak to attendees regarding women in technology.
- d) Culminate the All That TECH Conference with a one evening Juneteenth STEM Festival in June where the community at large is invited to come and learn about technology through the history, present, and future of Black Americans in STEM. All facilitators will be JCPS high school juniors/seniors.
- e) Follow all JCPS health and safety guidelines when staff, students, or volunteers enter JCPS buildings.
- f) Not use the name or logo of JCPS, All That TECH Conference/Juneteenth STEM Festival, or individual JCPS schools in printed materials, websites, videos or social media without prior approval from JCPS Chief of Communications.
