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### **Instruction & Student Learning**

- Teachers are using formative assessment data during PLCs to identify student strengths and needs to refine instruction and interventions during WIN (What I Need) time.
- Classrooms continue strong implementation of Wonders (ELA) and Eureka (Math), with a focus on student discussion, collaboration, and deeper problem solving.
- Recent classroom visits highlighted engaged learners, thoughtful questioning, and purposeful small-group instruction across grade levels.

### **School Culture & Student Support**

- TigerPRIDE expectations (Purpose, Respect, Integrity, Determination, and Excellence) remain central to our work with students each day.
- In collaboration with the Northern Kentucky Cooperative for Educational Services (NKCES) and their Social-Emotional Learning Specialist, our fourth-grade team is implementing a “TigerPRIDE in Action” framework to reinforce respectful behavior and provide consistent responses when students struggle with expectations.
- Students demonstrating positive choices continue to be recognized through classroom celebrations, TigerPRIDE Student of the Month, and Character Strong recognitions.

### **Family & Community Engagement**

- Kindergarten Registration (March 4) provided an opportunity to welcome our newest families and share information about Grandview’s programs and kindergarten readiness expectations.
- Spring Parent-Teacher Conferences (March 11) allowed teachers and families to connect about student progress and set goals for continued growth.
- Grandview looks forward to hosting the GES Skoolaid Olympics (March 19), which brings students, staff, and volunteers together to celebrate teamwork and school spirit.
