

History/Background: All Emergency Certified Substitute applications (TC-4) are now administered through the online certification system of the Certification Office of the Educational Professional Standards Board. The Board order is necessary for processing the applications since part of this interactive process requires district staff to input data related to Board approval to seek these specific certificates. An Emergency Certified Substitute is an individual who has the necessary college hours but lacks a Kentucky Teaching Certificate.
